Thank you for your interest in volunteering for Comfort Zone at the Rutland United Methodist Church. We serve between 80-100 hot breakfasts each day and need volunteers for all areas of responsibility. BREAKFAST PREPARATION

Arrive at the church by 7:30 am Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and/or Thursday

- Entree prep - could involve making the food from scratch or heating casseroles.
- Make up paper bags with utensils, fruit, juice, and other items as directed.
- Set up take out containers.
- Make coffee and serve to early arrivals.

BREAKFAST SERVERS

Arrive at church by 8:30 am Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and/or Thursday

- Serve breakfasts to our guests.



CLEANING CREW

Arrive at church by 10:00 am

- Clean up after breakfast has been served - wash pots, kitchen equipment and dishes.
- Wipe down surfaces in kitchen and serving area.
- Sweep, vacuum, and mop as needed.

OFF-HOURS PREPARATIONS

Contact us at the church to find a mutually agreeable time on Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, and/or Wednesday.

- Pack up bags that accompany breakfast.
- Package individual servings of fruit, baked goods, yogurt, butter, cream cheese, syrup - whichever is needed for the next day.



AT-HOME VOLUNTEERING

Please give us a call at the Church to coordinate these efforts.

- Prepare an entree for breakfast such as a sweet or savory casserole that can be prepared ahead of time. Drop it off at the church the day before it is to be served.
- Make some baked goods - brownies, cookies, muffins, etc. (If you can wrap them individually, that helps too.)
